

A2408 – Item 24-58: Adding a wreath retaining wire and to repair the leadwork on the 305th BG(H) memorial.

Background: In April, Cllr Seaman asked that a method of securing the wreaths to the 305th BG(H) memorial to be considered, so as to avoid them blowing about, including on to the road.

The Stonemason used to maintain the memorial, Robert Farrow, was consulted and suggested a simple solution of two eyelets on the sides (so not disturbing the front face). This was quoted at £50. Whilst originally proposed under SO26, ClIrs Hill and Smith have asked for this to "called in" to full Council to consider.

In the intervening period, sometime between 26th May and 26th June, persons unknown attempted to remove the lead capping from the 305th BG(H) war memorial, causing minor damage (edges pulled out, upper surface rumpled as per image below).

The attempt to remove the lead was unsuccessful on this occasion, and has been reported to Northants Police (crime number 24000389179).



Proposal: The Council is requested approve the retaining wire eyelets and consider the quotation for the leadwork repairs once received.
